Immingham Habrough & Stallingborough Report for February

Crime

There were 48 crimes recorded for January in the Immingham, Habrough and Stallingborough area of the NPT.

These included:

Vehicle Crime 1: During the early hours of 15th January a car parked at its address on Mayfields Court Stallingborough was entered. Alcohol and cash were stolen.

Criminal Damage 9:

A brick was thrown through a house window on Thornbury Road.

A brick was thrown through a window on Carisbrooke Walk.

A car had paint sprayed on its bodywork whilst parked on Alden Close.

A car was damaged after another car drove into it and then the driver caused damage to the wing with an implement.

Cars were damaged on Birkdale Drive after using an implement to dent the bodywork.

A car window was damaged whilst parked on Roundway after the nearside window was smashed.

A car parked on Ings Lane was damaged when a roof tile was used to damage wing mirrors, bodywork, and windscreen.

One domestic related damage.

Other crime includes:

Eleven assaults.

Eight minor public order offences.

Six shop thefts.

Three offences of harassment.

Theft of a lawnmower from a garden on Blair Walk.

There have been five ASB reported.

Youths causing issues on Homestead Park.

Motorbike being ridden illegally on Leyden Close.

Speeding vehicles Church Lane.

Two neighbour disputes.
