## Immingham Habrough & Stallingborough Report for January

### Crime

Of the 74 crimes recorded for December in the Immingham, Habrough and Stallingborough area of the NPT, there have been the following incidents:

#### **Burglary Residential – 2**

Overnight 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> December an attempt was made to enter a property on Woodlands Avenue by forcing the door. No entry was made.

Just before 11pm on 18<sup>th</sup> December unknown persons tried the door handle of a property on Blair Walk. The door was locked so no entry was made.

#### **Burglary Commercial – 4**

A local man has been charged with burglary following a break-in at Jacks on 5<sup>th</sup> December.

During the morning of 8<sup>th</sup> December a disused factory on Immingham Docks was broken into. A search was made of the premises but nothing was stolen.

About 11.20pm on 24<sup>th</sup> December entry was made into the Aldi store after a window was smashed. Alcohol was stolen.

Overnight 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> December an attempt was made to force entry to Eden Beauty Parlour. Despite damaging the shutter, no entry was made.

#### **Vehicle Crime – 5**

Overnight 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> December power tools were stolen from an insecure car parked on Somerton Road.

Overnight 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> December a motorbike was stolen from a garden on Pelham Road.

Over the same period a motorbike was stolen from outside an address on Humberville Road. The bike was later recovered hidden nearby.

During the early hours of 25<sup>th</sup> December an unknown male entered a vehicle parked on the swimming pool carpark by unknown means and attempted to set fire to it. Luckily the fire didn't take hold and no damage was caused.

Overnight 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> December a motorbike was stolen from outside an address on Sackville Road.

### **Damage – 8**

Jacks damage to a window. One male charged.  
Lloyds Bank window smashed.  
Margaret Street car window smashed.  
Pelham Road damage to a car.  
Dene Road damage to a wall.  
Pelham Road damage to fence panels.  
Marsh Road Stallingborough damage caused to security lights.  
One domestic related damage to a building.

### **Shop Theft – 8**

A male has been charged with three of these offences.

Two making off without payment for fuel, one each from the Bluestone Service Station and Luxmore.  
Six reports of harassment
