Immingham Habrough & Stallingborough Report for January

Crime

There were 56 crimes recorded for November in the Immingham, Habrough and Stallingborough area of the NPT.

These included: One residential burglary at Healing House.

One commercial burglary at Luxmore Service Station.

One tampering with a motor vehicle.

Seven reports of criminal damage.

Twelve assaults.

One male was charged with possession of a drug.

For December there have been 28 reported crimes to date. Of these, the following offences have occurred:

Vehicle Offences – 1

Groceries were stolen from a supermarket delivery van on Hadleigh Road on 4th December.

Damage – 1

A window was damaged at a flat at Healing House.

Other crime include:

Eight assaults.

Five minor public order offences.

Four shop thefts. A male has been charged with one of these offences from Aldi.

ASB – 18 including:

YCA Kennedy Way x4.

Neighbour disputes x4

Hadleigh Road persons causing ASB against the same victim x3.

Premier Store Hadleigh Road YCA x3.

Motorbikes being ridden illegally x2.

Pelham hotel YCA.
