## Immingham Habrough & Stallingborough Report for June

### Crime

Of the 72 crimes recorded for May in the Immingham, Habrough and Stallingborough area of the NPT, there have been the following incidents:

#### **Burglary Residential – 2**

During the early hours of 24<sup>th</sup> May a garage at a property on South Marsh Road Stallingborough was entered after the door was forced. A moped was stolen. During the evening of 24<sup>th</sup> May a property on Pelham Road was entered after a door window was smashed to gain entry. A bike was stolen from inside the premises.

#### **Vehicle Crime – 2**

Overnight 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> May a motorbike was stolen from outside an address on Clyfton Crescent. It was later recovered. During the early hours of 16<sup>th</sup> June a vehicle was taken from a home address by a family member without permission. The car was later involved in a collision. The driver was also arrested for driving under the influence of drink and drugs. During the early hours of 24<sup>th</sup> May a motorbike was an address at Pilgrims Way. The bike was later returned.

#### **Damage – 8**

McColl's Kennedy Way damage to a shop door window.  
Lansdown Road damage to a door.  
Manby Road damage to a vehicle.  
Hadleigh Road damage to a car.  
Today's Local store Waterworks Street. During altercation the shop door was damaged.  
Pilgrim Avenue damage to garden furniture after a bike was thrown over a garden fence.  
Kiln Lane damage perimeter fence to gain entry to Industrial compound.
