## Immingham Habrough & Stallingborough Report for March

### Crime

There were 39 crimes recorded for February (to date) in the Immingham, Habrough and Stallingborough area of the NPT. These included:

#### **Burglary Business & Commercial: 1**

During the afternoon of 20<sup>th</sup> February a storage container at the new construction off Stallingborough Interchange was broken into. A hole was cut into the side and the metal pulled away revealing a large enough hole to remove a generator.

#### **Damage – 6**

Ancholme Avenue house window smashed.

Mayflower Avenue damage caused to a car by smashing all the windows and denting all bodywork panels.

Stallingborough Road smash drivers side window of a truck.

Hadleigh Road damage caused to car windows.

Cushman Crescent tyres slashed on a trailer.

Sonja Crest damage to fencing.

#### **Other crime include:**

Twelve assaults.

Two minor public order offences.

Five offences of sending malicious communications.

Two domestic related reports of harassment. Theft of scrap metal and vehicle parts from a skip at a premises on Stallingborough Industrial Estate.

**ASB – 5 including:**

A report of loud music from a home on Church Lane.

A report of fires being lit in a garden on Church Lane.

Noisy motorbike on Eaton Road.

Two reports in relation to alleged breach of Covid regulations.
